Spelling	This week we are looking at a collection of words that can be used as both nouns and verbs. For example: The doctor's surgery launched a new health scheme that would benefit everyone in the local community. The word benefit is being used as a verb in this sentence - it is saying the scheme would help the community. The company offered a pension plan, a company car and a health benefit scheme to their new employees. The same word (benefit) is doing the job of a noun - it is talking about a thing. Below is an activity in which you need to put each of your spelling words into a sentence. For each spelling, look to see whether you are being asked to use the word as a noun or a verb.		✓
