Glossary:

Growth mind-set: people who believe that their most basic abilities can be developed through dedication and hard work.

Equality: means that people have the same rights and opportunities regardless of what they look like or where they come from.

Stereotype: is a category, or a group, that we put people into. (For example: women cook and men do DIY.)
